Student-Athletes, Coaches Earn Top Honors from *Miami Herald*

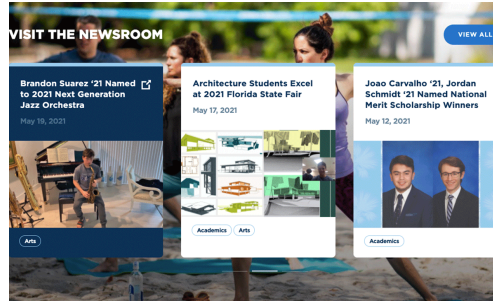

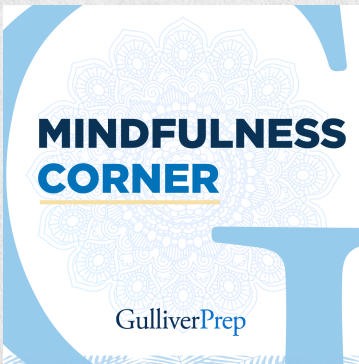
