National Signing Day

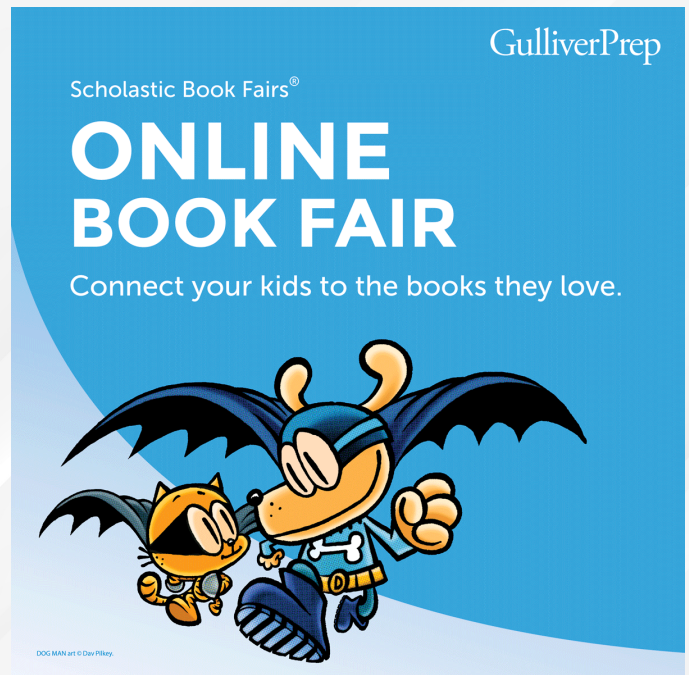
