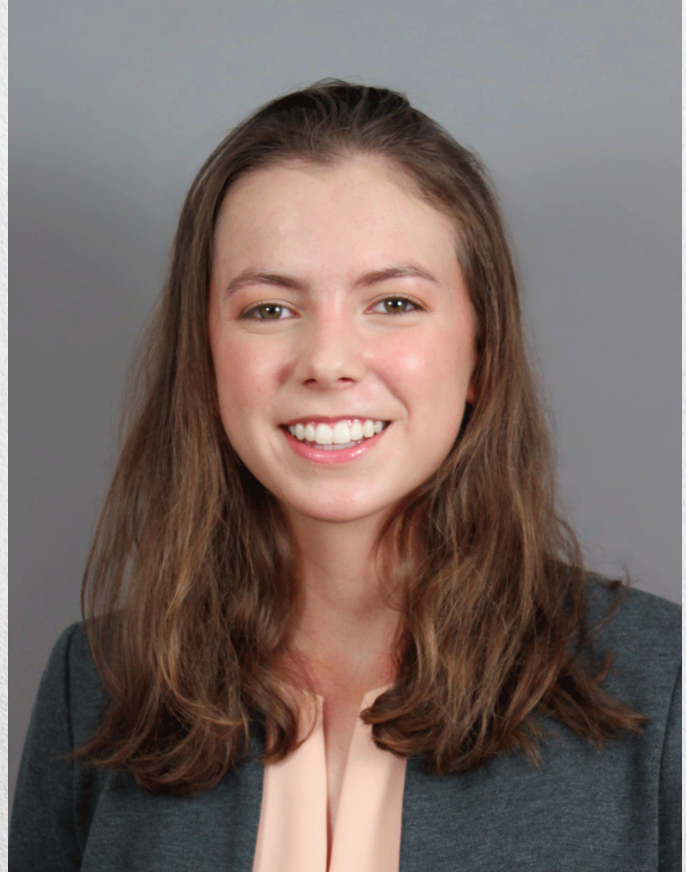

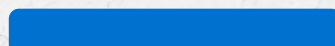
### Mandatory Health Forms
